

ORDINANCE NO. 5-78  
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Dave Lake ON THE 30th DAY  
OF January, 1978.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SALARY PAYMENTS AND  
OVERTIME PAYMENTS FOR THE TWO CRISIS DAYS THE CITY OFFICES WERE  
CLOSED BECAUSE OF THE SNOW EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on January 26, 1978 and January 27, 1978, the offices of  
the City of Centerville were closed due to a snow emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Centerville has determined that  
those employees who were unable to work because the City offices were closed  
should not thereby be penalized financially and that those employees who did  
work should receive extra compensation;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That those employees who were unable to work on <sup>the crisis days of</sup> January  
26 and January 27, 1978, because of the City offices being closed shall be  
paid for those days the same as if those said days were legal holidays for  
which they would have been paid pursuant to Ordinance Number 59-77.

Section 2. That those employees who <sup>were required</sup> to work for the City of  
Centerville on <sup>the crisis days of</sup> January 26 and January 27, 1978, shall be paid for those days  
at the same rate they would have been paid for a legal holiday pursuant to  
Ordinance Number 59-77 and, in addition thereto, they shall be paid for those  
hours actually worked at 1 1/2 times their regular pay rate.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency  
measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency  
affecting public health, safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist by  
virtue of the fact that immediate action of the Council must be taken to allow  
the City employees to be paid on their regular pay day.
