AN ORDINANCE <sup>RE</sup> ~~APPEALING~~ PART 7-BUSINESS REGULATION CODE OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Part 7-Business Regulation Code Section 707.01 and 707.99 as set forth in brackets as follows is hereby repealed:

[ 707.01 ANNUAL LICENSE FEE

Each proprietor of premises containing a billard or pool table or of a bowling alley, or a combination of both, shall pay an annual license fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for one such table; twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for one such alley; and ten dollars (\$10.00) for each additional table or each additional alley.]

[ 707.99 PENALTY

Whoever violates any provision of this chapter shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00).]


Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.


