## ORDINANCE NO. 4/1-77 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Russell Sweetman ON THE 17th DAY OF Ortober, 1977.

An Ordinance establishing procedures permitting sidewalk sales in business districts and amending Ordinance 15-61 The Zoning Ordinance.

The Municipality of Centerville hereby ordains:

Section 1. That Section 22 or Ordinance 15-61 is hereby amended as follows:

- O. (1) The owner or operator of a business located in a Bl, B2, B3, Entrance Corridor, or AP district may apply to the Administrative Officer for permission to operate a sale outside of his business premises whether on private property or upon the public sidewalk adjacent to his business premises. The applicant shall, in his application, give a description of the proposed sale, the hours of operation and the duration, not to exceed 3 days. The applicant shall also deposit with the City the sum of \$ 75.00 as security for the restoration of the site of the sale to the condition it was in prior to the sale and to assure the conduct of the sale according to the description in the application. If the site of the sale is not restored to its condition prior to the sale within days following the termination of the sale, or if the sale is not carried out according to the description in the application, the City shall cause said restoration and the applicant shall forfeit said deposit.
  - Sidewalk sales by persons who are not the owners or operators of a business may be permitted in the Architectural Preservation District in connection with a planned program involving at least & separate sellers. In such event the provisions of the previous paragraph (1) shall apply and, in addition, a general plan of the entire planned program shall be submitted. Provided, however, that in the event of a planned program under this paragraph, the total security deposit shall not exceed \$ 75.000 and only one application by the person in charge of the planned program need be filed.

Section 2. That Section 15C of Ordinance 15-61 is hereby amended as follows:

13. Sales or Displays outside of Buildings in the Business Districts are hereby prohibited excepting sales of gasoline or oil at Filling Stations [.] and except as otherwise specifically permitted herein.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
