

ORDINANCE NO. 44-77

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

Sponsored by Councilman Russell Sweetman on the 19th day of September, 1977.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF KENTSHIRE DRIVE TO MARSHALL ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Council has received a petition signed by a property owner of a lot within the municipal corporation and abutting on Kentshire Drive asking that the name of a portion of Kentshire Drive be changed to Marshall Road; and

WHEREAS, the municipality has the power to change a street name upon such petition by virtue of section 723.04 Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Kentshire Drive, as dedicated to the public in Village South Plat (plat book 88, page 74), extending from the easterly plat line in a southwesterly direction a distance of 467.92 feet, is hereby renamed to Marshall Road.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.


