OF February, 1976.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO APPOINT SHIRLEY HEINTZ TO THE
CENTERVILLE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD AND FIXING A TERM
OF OFFICE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Shirley Heintz is hereby appointed to the Parks and
Recreation Board for a term of three (3) years commencing with the effective
date of this Ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency
affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact
that Shirley Heintz has been acting as chairman of the Parks and Recreation
Board and her term did expire on February 2, 1976. The continued effective-
ness of said Board depends upon its having full membership.
