AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 957, REFUSE COLLECTION, OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE BY PROVIDING CERTAIN HARDSHIP EXEMPTIONS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AND PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY FOR THE COUNTY DISPOSAL FEE FROM OWNERS OF PROPERTY SUBJECT TO SAID FEE AND NOT PRESENTLY SERVICED BY CENTERVILLE REFUSE COLLECTION.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 957 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of the following sections:

Section 957.08. HARDSHIP EXEMPTIONS. Exemptions from the operation of this chapter may be granted by the City Manager upon proper application to him made by citizens of the City of Centerville over the age of sixty-two who, in said application, can demonstrate that the payment of the refuse collection fees herein provided causes a financial hardship, and, further, that the services provided pursuant to this chapter are not needed by said applicant. In accordance with Section 957.04, the Department of Service shall make the necessary rules and regulations governing the applications for said exemptions.

Section 957.09. The City shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for county disposal fees paid by the City to Montgomery County, Ohio, from owners of property within the City of Centerville which owners are subject to said fee and which properties are not presently serviced by city refuse collection. The Department of Service shall make all the necessary rules and regulations governing the collection of said reimbursement.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date provided by law.
