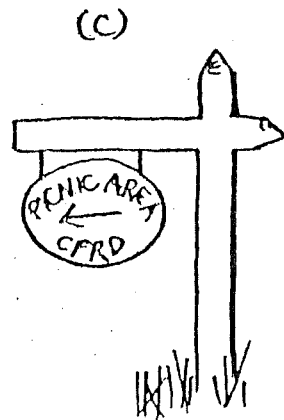
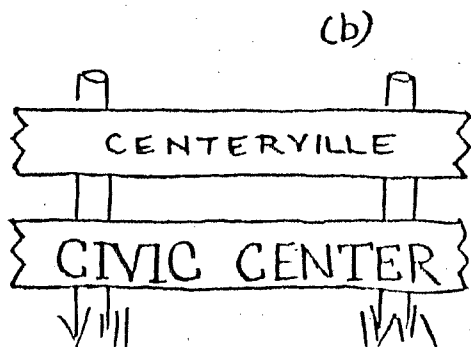
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 555.14 OF THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE ERECTING AND ATTACHING SIGNS.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The existing Section 555.14 of the Centerville Municipal Code shall remain as presently provided but shall carry the prefix (a).

Section 2. Section 555.14 of the Centerville Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of the following sub sections:

- (b) Main entrance or primary designation signs shall have lettering routed in wood and be similar to federal, state, and park district in general style. Size and location is to conform with city standards.
- (c) Signs for direction and area identification within the parks shall be oval faced, similar in shape and style to Centerville Architectural Preservation District street signs. Mountings are to be appropriate to the area or purpose. Wording or symbols are to be designated by the Director of Parks and Recreation.



Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
