AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 15 DATED DECEMBER 11, 1961, THE ZONING ORDINANCE, BY RE-ZONING 89.248 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, FROM CENTERVILLE R-3 CLASSIFICATION TO CENTERVILLE R-1 CLASSIFICATION.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the zoning map attached to Ordinance No. 15, passed on the 11th day of December, 1961, and as subsequently amended, be, and the same hereby is, revised as follows:

By changing the zoning of the following described property from Centerville R-3 Classification to Centerville R-1 Classification:

Located in Section 19, Town 2, Range 6 M.R.S., Washington Township, Montgomery County, City of Centerville, State of Ohio; being all of the lands conveyed to Black Oak Development Company (Microfiche 74122D04) and being the lands involved in the rezoning case Z-76-3 initiated by the City of Centerville; being more particularly described as follows:

Starting at the intersection of Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road and Clyo Road. Thence along the centerline of Clyo Road in a southerly direction, 454 feet to the real point of beginning of the lands to be described herein.

Thence, from said point of beginning, along the boundary lines of said Black Oak Development lands the following courses and distances:

South $89^{\circ}-45'-50''$ East, a distance of 201.10 feet South $88^{\circ}-52'$ East, a distance of 1,759.26 feet South $3^{\circ}-10'-20''$ West, a distance of 1,227.25 feet South $3^{\circ}-12'-30''$ West, a distance of 1,010.50 feet North $86^{\circ}-47'-30''$ West, a distance of 644.71 feet North 2°-50' East, a distance of 320.00 feet North 87°-10' West, a distance of 1,300.00 feet North 2°-50' East, a distance of 1,638.02 feet along the centerline of Clyo Road North 2°-37'-10" East, a distance of 214.17 feet

along the centerline of Clyo Road

to the point of beginning, containing 89.248 acres (eighty-nine and 248/1000) acres, more or less, subject however to all rights-of-way, easements, conditions and restrictions on record.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
