CITY OF CENTERVILLE

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Russell Sweetman ON THE 18th DAY OF October, 1976.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 9-69, ARTICLE 21, UNIFIED BUILDING CODE RELATING TO FEES.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Ordinance 9-69, Article 21, Section 2102.0 Fees for Permits is hereby amended as follows:

Table 2102.01. Fee Schedule

Cost of Work to be Done	Fee
[Less than \$501.00]	[\$3.00]
[\$501.00 to \$1,001.00]	[\$5.00]
[\$1,001.00 to \$50,001.00]	[\$5.00 plus an additional fee of \$2.00 for each \$1,000.00 or fraction thereof in excess of \$1,000.00.]
[<u>\$50,001.00 to \$250,001.00</u>]	[\$103.00 plus an additional fee of \$1.50 for each \$1,000.00 cost or fraction thereof in excess of \$50,000.00.]
[<u>\$250,001.00 to \$500,001.00</u>]	[\$403.00 plus an additional fee of \$1.00 for each \$1,000.00 cost or fraction thereof in excess of \$250,000.00.]
[<u>\$500,001.00 and over</u>]	[\$653.00 plus an additional fee of \$0.50 for each \$1,000.00 cost or fraction thereof in excess of \$500,000.00.]
<u>Less than \$1,000.00</u>	<u>\$10.00</u>
<u>\$1,000.00 to \$25,000.00</u>	<u>\$10.00 plus an additional fee of \$2.50 for each \$1,000.00 cost or fraction thereof in excess of \$1,000.00.</u>
<u>\$25,001.00 to \$50,000.00</u>	<u>\$70.00 plus an additional fee of \$2.00 for each \$1,000.00 cost or fraction thereof in excess of \$25,001.00.</u>
<u>\$50,001.00 to \$250,000.00</u>	<u>\$120.00 plus an additional fee of \$1.50 for each \$1,000.00 cost or fraction thereof in excess of \$50,001.00.</u>
<u>\$250,001.00 to \$500,000.00</u>	<u>\$420.00 plus an additional fee of \$1.00 for each \$1,000.00 cost or fraction thereof in excess of \$250,001.00.</u>
<u>\$500,001 and over</u>	<u>\$670.00 plus an additional fee of \$0.50 for each \$1,000.00 cost or fraction thereof in excess of \$500,001.00.</u>

"Cost" shall be estimated at \$15.00 per square foot of construction less mechanical unless proof of construction cost is furnished in which event "cost" shall be based upon such proof.


