
AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING Geo. J. Schottmiller

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:


Section 1. George J. Schottmiller is hereby appointed to membership  
on the Centerville Planning Commission for the unexpired term of John Myers.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to become an emergency  
measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An  
emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the  
fact that the Centerville Planning Commission must have full membership in  
order to adequately handle all of the business to come before it.




