
AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING NANCY S. LANDL
AS A MEMBER ON THE BICENTENNIAL
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:


Section I. Nancy S. Landl is hereby appointed as a member of the Bicentennial Commission of the City of Centerville, Ohio to serve for the full period of existence of said Commission.

Section II. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the City of Centerville, for the good of its citizens has determined to undertake the establishment of a Bicentennial Commission and the immediate formation of said Commission is essential in order to allow the activities to be undertaken by the Commission to be immediately commenced.

PASSED this 19th day of May, 1975.


