

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING NANCY LANDL AS
CHAIRMAN OF THE CENTERVILLE BICENTENNIAL COMMISSION
OF THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION.

Section I. Nancy Landl is hereby appointed Chairman of the
Centerville Bicentennial Commission of the American Revolution to serve as
Chairman for the full period of existence of said Commission


Section II. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency
affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact
that the City of Centerville, for the good of its citizens has established

to coordinate activities undertaken by the Commission.


