CITY COUNCIL.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 25-69 is hereby amended as follows:


"A. MEMBERSHIP AND TERMS. The Council of the City
of Centerville hereby establishes a City Planning Commission
consisting of seven (7) members to be appointed by the Council.
[One (1) member shall be a member of the Council; six (6)]
All members shall be electors of the City who shall serve
without compensation, and the City Manager shall be a
member, ex officio."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the
earliest date allowed by law.


