

ORDINANCE NO. 56-75

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN Charles McGowan ON THE 20th DAY OF October, 1975.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE SISTER CITY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR TERMS OF THREE YEARS.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. John Spoor and Dale A. Rodman are hereby appointed as members of the Sister City Committee of the City of Centerville, Ohio for terms of three years.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the City of Centerville, for the good of its citizens has determined to undertake a Sister City Program and the immediate appointment of members to the Committee is essential in order to allow the activities to be undertaken by the Committee to be immediately commenced.
