
AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING DAVID TOOKER TO THE PERSONNEL APPEALS BOARD OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR A THREE YEAR TERM EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 1976.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:


Section 1. David Tooker is hereby appointed to the Personnel Appeals Board of the City of Centerville for a term expiring December 31, 1976.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the Personnel Appeals Board is now without its full membership and full membership on such Board is necessary for the orderly execution of the business of the City.
