AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO RATIFY AND APPROVE THE ACTING CITY MANAGER IN EXECUTING A WRITTEN COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE DAYTON PUBLIC SERVICE UNION, LOCAL NO. 101, AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE. COUNTY, AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, AFL-CIO; AND TO AUTHORIZE RETROACTIVE COMPENSATION.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The action of the Acting City Manager in executing a written collective bargaining agreement with the Dayton Public Service Union, Local No. 101, American Federation of State, County, and Municipal employees, AFL-CIO with regard to wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment, said collective bargaining agreement to be for a period of three years commencing from and after May 10, 1974 through May 10, 1977, is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.

Section 2. Retroactive pay rates are hereby authorized for the compensation levels set forth in that contract for the period of time commencing with the effective date thereof.

Section 3. A copy of said collective bargaining agreement is attached hereto, marked Exhibit A and made a part hereof and an additional copy of the said collective bargaining agreement shall be maintained on file in the office of the finance director of the City of Centerville in order to be available for inspection.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately upon passage. A public emergency affecting public welfare is determined to exist on the basis that it is necessary to ratify, confirm and approve the signing of said collective bargaining agreement immediately and that it is necessary to authorize such retroactive pay to insure the continuing high moral of the employees covered by the contract which will help to perserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare.
