AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING THAYER D. THOMPSON,
ACTING CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR AN
INDETERMINATE PERIOD COMMENCING JUNE 1, 1974.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Thayer D. Thompson is hereby appointed to serve as acting
City Manager for the City of Centerville for an indeterminate period commencing
June 1, 1974 and with all the rights, powers and duties of the City Manager as
set forth in the charter and ordinances of this municipality.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency
affecting public health, safety and welfare is declared to exist by virtue of the
fact that James R. Smith, City Manager of the City of Centerville, has resigned
said position effective June 1, 1974 and the city government cannot function
without a City Manager.
