AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 40-74 RELATING TO COUNCIL SALARIES.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Ordinance 40-74 amending Ordinance 10-69 and as hereafter set forth in brackets, is hereby repealed:

Section 1. Beginning January 1, 1970, in accordance with Section 4.07, City Charter, each member of the City Council of Centerville, Ohio, shall be paid the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars each regular, special or work session meeting attended by said member, not to exceed four (4) paid meetings per month. [provided, however, that with respect to those members of Council commencing new terms of office on January 1, 1976 and thereafter, each such member shall be paid as follows: an amount equal to \$.05 per One Thousand Dollars of real estate tax valuation as may appear on the records of the Montgomery County Auditor. Adjustments to Council salaries in accordance with the formula provided herein shall be made at such times as the Montgomery County Auditor shall certify the total real estate tax valuation to the City of Centerville.]

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that Ordinance 40-74 will, if not repealed, become effective on June 20, 1974 and this can only be prevented by the passage of an emergency measure.
