AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING SHIRLEY MOORE MCGOWAN TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF FREDRICK O. FOCKE ON THE BOARD OF ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Shirley Moore McGowan is hereby appointed as a member of the Board of Architectural Review to serve the remainder of the unexpired term of Fredrick O. Focke who has resigned as a member of said Board.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency effecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the Board of Architectural Review requires full membership at all times in order to allow it to carry out its duties.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
