DESIGNATING A SALARY.


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Section 3A Table of Organization of Ordinance 60-74 is hereby amended as follows:



Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective on December 15, 1974. An emergency affecting public health, safety, and general welfare is declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the City is presently without the services of a full time City Manager and a full time City Manager has been hired effective December 15, 1974.
