AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7-71  
RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE CLERK OF THE COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 7-71, passed on the first  
day of February, 1971 as hereinafter stated is hereby amended as follows:

The salary of the Clerk of Council and Clerk of Mayor's Court is  
hereby established at \$ 8200<sup>00</sup> per year, payable in equal weekly  
installments, beginning with the first day of January, 1973. In addition  
to the foregoing, the Clerk of Council and Mayor's Court shall be a full  
time employee within the context of the provisions of Ordinance Number 82-72  
relating to benefits and shall be entitled to the benefits therein provided.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency  
measure affecting public welfare and shall become effective immediately upon  
passage. An emergency affecting public welfare exists by virtue of the fact  
that the City presently has a Clerk of its Council and Mayor's Court who must  
be adequately compensated.
