AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING JAMES M. GALLAGHER TO THE BOARD OF ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR A THREE YEAR TERM COMMENCING APRIL 17, 1973.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That James M. Gallagher is hereby appointed to serve as a member of the Board of Architectural Review of the City of Centerville for a three year term commencing April 17, 1973.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the term of the present member of the Board of Architectural Review expires on April 16, 1973, and the Board cannot properly act for the benefit and protection of all of the citizens of Centerville without the full membership.
