AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF
IRWIN ENTERPRISES
FOR THE INTERIOR FINISHING OR FURNISHINGS FOR
THE CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL BUILDING AND AUTHOR-
IZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT
WITH SAID CONTRACTOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY
UPON THE POSTING OF THE PROPER PERFORMANCE BOND
BY THE CONTRACTOR.

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bidders for the interior
finishing and furnishings for the new Municipal Building for the
City of Centerville, pursuant to specifications prepared by the
City; and


WHEREAS, Irwin Enterprises

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The bid of Irwin Enterprises to supply
Tackboards
for the new Municipal Building for the City of Centerville which
bid was for a total of Two Hundred Fourteen Dollars
(\$214.00) for the base bid is hereby accepted and the City
Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract
for the interior finishing or furnishings as set forth in said
specifications in the form of contract set forth in said
specifications upon the posting of the proper performance bond by
said contractor in accordance with the said specification.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective from and
after the earliest date allowed by law.
