
AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING ELMER C. TATE, JR. TO THE CENTERVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR A TERM OF THREE YEARS COMMENCING JUNE 5, 1973.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:


Section 1. That Elmer C. Tate, Jr. is hereby appointed a member of the Centerville Planning Commission for a three year term commencing June 5, 1973.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an Emergency Ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the Centerville Planning Commission is responsible for zoning in the City of Centerville, among other functions, pursuant to the protection of public health, safety, morals and general welfare and full membership on said body is essential at all times for said protection.


