

ORDINANCE NO. 66-73

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF FINKE CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR GENERAL CONTRACT WORK IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE EAST FRANKLIN STREET IMPROVEMENT, WHICH IMPROVEMENT WAS AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 60-73 AND ORDINANCE 61-73 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH SAID CONTRACTOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY UPON THE POSTING OF THE PROPER PERFORMANCE BOND BY THE CONTRACTOR.

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bidders for the work of general contractor for the construction of the East Franklin Street improvement as described in Ordinance 60-73 and Ordinance 61-73 for the City of Centerville, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City; and

WHEREAS, Finke Construction Co. was the lowest and best bidder;

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The bid of Finke Construction Co. to be the general contractor on the proposed East Franklin Street improvement for the City of Centerville which bid was for a total of Sixty Five Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Four and 55/100 Dollars (\$65,624.55) for the base bid is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the construction work as set forth in said specifications in the form of contract set forth in said specifications upon the posting of the proper performance bond by said contractor in accordance with the said specification.


Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public health, safety and welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the present condition of East Franklin Street is totally inadequate to serve the citizens of Centerville and the best interests of the citizens of the City of Centerville will only be served by the immediate commencement of construction.
