AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REAPPOINTING JOHN A. DAVIS TO THE CENTERVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE REMAINDER OF HIS TERM AS CENTERVILLE COUNCIL MEMBER.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That John A. Davis is hereby appointed as a member of the Centerville Planning Commission for the remainder of his present term as member of the Centerville Council.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that John A. Davis' term as member of the Centerville Planning Commission has expired and his continued service on the Centerville Planning Commission is essential in order for the Planning Commission to function properly.
