ORDINANCE NO. 1-72

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN JOHN W. MCINTIRE ON THE 3RD DAY OF JANUARY, 1972.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE CITY MANAGER AS THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICIAL CHARGED WITH ADMINISTERING AND ENFORCING THE BUILDING CODE.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby designated as the administrative official charged with the duties of administering the building code and he is hereby authorized and directed to cause all of the provisions of the building code to be carried out and, in connection therewith, he is authorized and directed to cause the prosecution for any violations of the building code of the City of Centerville which code was previously adopted by the City of Centerville by Ordinance 9-69.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby declared qualified to administer and enforce the Uniform Building Code previously adopted by Ordinance 9-69 by virtue of his being ultimately responsible for supervision of the building inspector and the activities of building inspection. The City Manager is hereby authorized to designate any member of the Building Inspection Department, licensed by the State of Ohio to act as a building inspector for the City of Centerville, as his duly authorized representative to administer and enforce the Uniform Building Code as provided by said Code.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon passage. A public emergency affecting public health and safety exists by virtue of the fact that an administrative official is immediately needed to administer and enforce the Uniform Building Code.
