AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING RONALD H. JANETZKE TO  
THE PERSONNEL APPEALS BOARD

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1.

That Ronald H. Janezke is hereby appointed to the Personnel Appeals Board of the City of Centerville, Ohio for a term of three (3) years commencing January 1, 1972.

SECTION II

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance that shall become effective immediately upon passage. A public emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that, due to expiration of a term on the Personnel Appeals Board, the Board is presently without full membership and can, therefore, not adequately handle personnel matters which may be referred to it.
