ORDINANCE NO. 46-72

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN RUSSELL SWEETMAN ON THE 17th DAY OF JULY, 1972.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE YOUTH BOARD OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 15-71.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. In accordance with the terms of Ordinance 15-71 the Council hereby appoints the following members to serve on the Youth Board for the terms set forth opposite their names.

1. Thomas Turner to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Virginia Ronald and to serve for the remainder of her term which expires on July 7, 1973.
2. Glenn E. Aidt to serve for a term of three (3) years commencing July 8, 1972.
3. Paul Buhr to serve for a term of three (3) years commencing July 8, 1972.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and the same shall become effective immediately upon passage. A public emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that a resignation of one member of the Youth Board has been received and the terms of two other members have expired resulting in the Youth Board being reduced to three existing members and a full Youth Board should exist to adequately administer its duties.
