SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN JOHN MCINTIRE ON THE 7TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1972.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER (DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE) TO ADVERTISE THE PROPOSED MUNICIPAL OFFICE BUILDING FOR PUBLIC BID.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The City Manager and Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to advertise the proposed municipal office building for public bid in accordance with the provisions of Title 7 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately on passage. An emergency affecting public welfare exists by virtue of the immediate need for a new municipal building.
