ORDINANCE NUMBER 50-72
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN J. V. STONE ON THE 21st DAY OF AUGUST, 1972.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE WHO IS THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A RAILROAD CROSSING AT THE INTERSECTION OF EAST RAHN ROAD AND THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD TRACKS IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 735.05 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, Section 735.05 of the Ohio Revised Code requires that the Director of Public Service (City Manager in the City of Centerville) advertise for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City in the event of a contract under the Department of Public Service involving more than One Thousand Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the estimates received from the engineer engaged by the City indicate that the expenditure will exceed One Thousand Five Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City Manager as Director of Public Service of the City is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of a railroad crossing on East Rahn Road at the Pennsylvania Railroad tracks in compliance with Section 735.05 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public safety and general welfare is declared to exist by virtue of the traffic and safety problems resulting from the inability of traffic to presently cross East Rahn Road at the Pennsylvania Railroad tracks.
