CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

Sponsored by Councilman John Davis on the 11th day of September, 1972.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF CHEVY CHASE DRIVE TO BRISTOL DRIVE.

Whereas the Council has received a petition signed by property owners of lots with the municipal corporation and abutting on Chevy Chase Drive asking that the name of Chevy Chase Drive be changed to Bristol Drive; and

Whereas a municipality has the power to change a street name upon such petition by virtue of Section 723.04 Ohio Revised Code,

Now, therefore,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

Section 1. The name of "Chevy Chase Drive" is hereby changed to "Bristol Drive" from its easternmost terminus at South Main Street to its westernmost terminus at Annette Drive.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
