## ORDINANCE NUMBER 63-72

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN CHARLES MCQUEENEY ON THE 16TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1972.

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING AND ACCEPTING THE OFFICIAL FLAG AND SEAL FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, a contest was held for the selection of a filag and seal which would most appropriately characterize the spirit of the community and symbolize the warmth of its residents; and

WHEREAS. flags and seals were submitted and a committee of the Mayor and citizens reviewed such flags and seals and caused a design to be accepted as a flag and seal and thereafter presented it to the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of the members of the administration and the Council that such flag and seal accomplishes the objectives of the first recital hereof, and accordingly will be designated as the flag and seal of the City of Centerville, Ohio, as more particularly hereinafter provided.

NOW. THEREFORE:

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section I. The flag and seal as hereinafter described be and are hereby proclaimed the official flag and seal of the City.

## Seal:

The seal shall be a circle with the words "Progress" and 'Stability" at the top in the border and "City of Centerville. Ohio" at the bottom in the border. Within the border there shall be a colonial frame which shall frame four stars at each corner with a large star in the center signifying the fact that Centerville is located at the center of an area bounded by Dayton, Miamisburg, Ridgeville and Springboro. At the bottom of the stars shall appear the words "Founded 1796".

## B. Flag:

The flag shall be a rectangle and divided in the middle vertically. The half of the flag nearest the staff shall be white with the seal of the City of Centerville super-imposed in the middle. The opposite half of the flag shall be horizon blue.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
