SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN LEONARD STUBBS ON THE 6th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1972.

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF JERRY SEUBERT COMPANY FOR MECHANICAL CONTRACT WORK IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW CENTERVILLE MUNICIPAL BUILDING AND RATIFYING THE ACTION OF THE CITY MANAGER IN EXECUTING A CONTRACT WITH SAID CONTRACTOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.
