AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO FILL A VACANCY PRESENTLY EXISTING BY VIRTUE OF THE RESIGNATION OF ROBERT ACKERMAN FOR THE REMAINDER OF SAID ROBERT ACKERMAN'S TERM,

WHEREAS, a vacancy on the Centerville Planning Commission now exists and must be filled in order for said Board to function properly; and

WHEREAS, said vacancy now exists by virtue of the resignation of Robert Ackerman;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Centerville hereby appoints John E. Myers to the Centerville Planning Commission for the remainder of the unexpired term of Robert Ackerman.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. An emergency affecting public welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the Centerville Planning Commission is one of most important Boards in the City of Centerville and it cannot properly function without a full membership.
