AN ~~EMERGENCY~~ ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE SERVICES OF A CITY PLANNER WITH ROBERT WINTERHALTER.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

Section 1. The proposed contract with Robert Winterhalter as City Planner for the City of Centerville which is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Centerville.

~~Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall become effective immediately upon passage. A public emergency affecting the general welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that the City has an immediate need for the services of a City Planner in order to insure the proper updating of the City Zoning Ordinance and subdivision regulations and to secure assistance in other planning functions. This Ordinance shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.~~
