

ORDINANCE NO. 77-72

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN John Davis
ON THE 8th DAY OF January, 19 73

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE AMOUNTS OF OFFICIAL BONDS TO BE POSTED BY CERTAIN NAMED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPALITY AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF PREMIUMS THEREON IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 12.02 OF THE CENTERVILLE CHARTER.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the following officers and employees of the municipality shall, in accordance with the provisions of Section 12.02 of the Charter of the City of Centerville, post a fidelity bond with the Clerk of the Council, said bond to be issued by a corporate surety authorized to do business in the State of Ohio to protect a municipality against loss due to the acts or omissions of said officers and employees as follows:

Director of Finance, \$25,000.00; Secretary of Director of Finance, \$25,000.00 and the following officers and employees shall each post a bond in the amount of \$2000.00, to-wit: Clerk of Council, City Engineer, Building Inspector, City Manager, Secretary to City Manager, Secretary for Waste Collection, Mayor, Councilmen, Police Dispatchers and Policemen.

Section 2. The premium on such bonds shall be paid from the funds of the municipality and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay said premiums.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date provided by law.
