ORDINANCE NO. 5-71

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 57-69 ESTABLISHING A PERSONNEL APPEALS BOARD, ADOPTING PERSONNEL RULES AND REGULATIONS AND APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE BOARD.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. In accordance with the provisions of Article X, Section 10.04 of the Centerville Charter, there has been established a Personnel Appeals Board consisting of three members and whereas the original term of John K. Buehl expired December 31, 1970, Ordinance Number 57-69, Section 3, passed on March 16, 1970 is hereby amended to read as follows:

John K. Buehl is hereby appointed to serve for a three-year term to commence on January 1, [1970] 1971 and to end December 31, [1970] 1973.

John E. Riley is hereby appointed to serve for a three-year term to commence on January 1, 1970 and to end December 31, 1972.

David R. Leigh is hereby appointed to serve for a two-year term to commence on January 1, 1970 and to end December 31, 1971.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
