ORDINANCE NO. 10-71

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 45-70 BY PROVIDING A PENALTY CHARGE FOR NON-PAYMENT OF REFUSE COLLECTION FEES.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

SECTION I. Section 3 of Ordinance 45-70, City of Centerville is hereby amended by the addition of the following language:

The fee for residential refuse collection service shall be \$4.00 per month, the fee shall be paid by all users of the service and, the City may bill in advance for one quarter or charge by the month. Customers shall be billed on a regular basis and if unpaid for 30 days, service to the premises may be discontinued and the owner of such premises may be duly prosecuted as provided in this ordinance. A second billing shall be made to customers whose bills are unpaid for a period of 30 days or more and a 20% penalty shall be added thereto and paid by the user.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance affecting the public health and general welfare and it shall become effective immediately upon passage. A public emergency exists by virtue of the large number of unpaid bills for refuse collection presently outstanding which affects the running of the refuse collection service.
