ORDINANCE NUMBER 17-71

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 4-71 OF FEBRUARY 1, 1971 FOR A TABLE OF ORGANIZATION, PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATIONS, RATES OF PAY, AND REGULATIONS FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance Number 4-71 is hereby amended to read as follows, with the portions repealed in brackets and the new portions underlined:

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public emergency affecting health, safety, and the public welfare is hereby declared to exist on the basis that it is necessary to revise the table of organization, classifications, rates of pay and personnel regulations at once in order to preserve the operating efficiency and morale of the Department of Public Safety and the Department of Public Service, Division of Refuse Collection.
