ORDINANCE NO. 22-71

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A PROPOSED AGREEMENT FROM THE CITY OF DAYTON, OHIO, FOR THE KEEPING OF PRISONERS AT THE HUMAN REHABILITATION CENTER DURING THE PERIOD APRIL 1, 1971 TO AND INCLUDING DECEMBER 31, 1971 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE SAID AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the City has received a Proposal from the City of Dayton, Ohio, concerning the keeping of prisoners at the Human Rehabilitation Center; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to accept said proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

SECTION 1. The proposal for the use of the Human Rehabilitation Center by the City of Centerville as set forth in the "Agreement" attached Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Centerville.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
