## ORDINANCE NUMBER 25-71

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF WYNSHIRE DRIVE TO FERNSHIRE DRIVE.

WHEREAS, a petition from an owner of a lot on Wynshire Drive, requesting the change of the name of Wynshire Drive to Fernshire Drive within the City has been received by Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that there is good cause for such change of name because the aforesaid streets are physically one street with Wynshire Drive being merely an extension of Fernshire Drive and this results in confusion for the citizens and users of the streets; and

WHEREAS, Council may change the name of said street as provided for in Section 723.04 Ohio Revised Code;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Section I. That the name of Wynshire Drive is hereby changed to Fernshire Drive from the present western terminus of Fernshire Drive where the two streets join and are intersected by Kentshire Drive, to the present western terminus of Wynshire Drive where it again meets Kentshire Drive.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
