### ORDINANCE NO. 29-71

Sponsored by Councilman Victor Green on the 3rd day of May, 1971.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 18-71 OF APRIL 5, 1971 FOR A TABLE OF ORGANIZATION, PERSONNEL CLASSIFICATIONS AND GRANTING RETROACTIVE PAY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

The Municipality of Centerville hereby ordains:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance Number 18-71 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the following police patrolmen are hereby granted a first anniversary grade increase effective as of the dates set opposite their names and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the said patrolmen the additional amounts of salary due from the dates specified herein resulting from the grade increases herein granted:

Patrolman Carl Reeder	August 4, 1970
Patrolman Timothy Fenlon	October 13, 1970

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
