ORDINANCE NO 30-71

Sponsored by Councilman Russell Sweetman on the 3rd day of May, 1971.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING RETROACTIVE PAY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

The Municipality of Centerville hereby ordains:

Section 1. That the following police dispatchers are hereby granted a first anniversary grade increase effective as of the date set opposite their names and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the said police dispatchers the additional amounts of salary due from the date specified herein resulting from the grade increases herein granted:

Police Dispatcher Shirley Copeland	January 13, 1969
Police Dispatcher Sue Link	August 31, 1969

Section 2. That police dispatcher Jean Lemon is hereby granted a first anniversary grade increase effective as of April 23, 1969 and the Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the said Jean Lemon the additional amounts of salary due her from the date specified herein resulting from the grade increase herein granted up to March 27, 1971, the date which she took a maternity leave from City employment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
