ORDINANCE NO. 32-71

Sponsored by Councilman John A. Davis, on the 3rd day of May, 1971.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF KING EQUIPMENT COMPANY TO SUPPLY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO WITH A USED TRACTOR WITH LOADER-BACKHOE.

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bidders for the furnishing of a used Tractor with Loader-Backhoe, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City; and

WHEREAS, King Equipment Company was the lowest and best bidder; and

WHEREAS, the bidding and the procedure followed conforms to the bidding procedure established by the City of Centerville.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Bid Quotation, attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary to cause said Bid Quotation to be accepted and to effectuate and pay for said purchase on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public emergency affecting the public welfare is hereby declared to exist because of the fact that the City of Centerville immediately needs to replace its existing Tractor with Loader-Backhoe which is no longer serviceable.
