AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF KING EQUIPMENT  
COMPANY TO SUPPLY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO  
WITH A USED TRACTOR WITH LOADER-BACKHOE

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bidders for the furnishing of a used  
Tractor with Loader-Backhoe, pursuant to specifications prepared by the City;  
and

WHEREAS, King Equipment Company was the lowest and best bidder;  
and

WHEREAS, the bidding and the procedure followed conforms to the  
bidding procedure established by the City of Centerville.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

and incorporated herein by reference is hereby accepted.

effectuate and pay for said purchase on behalf of the City.

date allowed by law.
