

ORDINANCE NO. 40-71

CITY OF CENTERVILLE

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMAN John Davis ON THE 7th DAY OF June, 1971.

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE INVESTMENT OF TREASURY FUNDS.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Whenever there are monies in the Treasury of the City of Centerville which would not be required to be used for a period of six (6) months or more, such monies, may in lieu of being deposited in a bank or banks, be invested in accordance with the provisions of Sections 731.56, 731.57, 731.58, and 731.59 of the Ohio Revised Code. Investments so purchased shall be sold in accordance with Section 731.57 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
