ORDINANCE NO. 53-71  
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR ANIMAL WARDEN SERVICES.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for Animal Warden services with Eugene R. Romer for the period commencing on July 14, 1971 and ending December 31, 1971 under the terms and conditions set forth in the contract attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon passage. A public emergency affecting public health, safety and general welfare is hereby declared to exist by virtue of the fact that after July 14, 1971 the City will be without an Animal Warden and will not have the protection offered by an Animal Warden.
