ORDINANCE NO. 55-71

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

Sponsored by Councilman Victor Green on the 2nd day of August, 1971.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO EXPIRING TERMS ON THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE NO. 25-69.

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. In accordance with the terms of Ordinance 25-69 the Council hereby appoints the following members to serve on the City Planning Commission for the terms set forth opposite their names:

- 1. Harold Wells to serve for a term of four years, commencing August 4, 1971.
- 2. Robert Ackerman to serve for a term of four years, commencing August 4, 1971.
- 3. Gary Maxton to serve for a term of four years, commencing August 4, 1971.

Section 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency Ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public emergency affecting health, safety and the public welfare is hereby declared to exist because of the fact that the City Planning Commission is presently unable to function without a full membership and the appointment of a full membership to serve thereon at the earliest possible date is essential in order that cases now pending may be processed.
