ORDINANCE NO. 57-71

CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

Sponsored by Councilman John Davis on the 2nd day of August, 1971.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE PERSONNEL APPEALS BOARD TO FILL A VACANCY PRESENTLY EXISTING FOR THE TERM EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 1973.

WHEREAS, John Buehl has resigned as a member of the Personnel Appeals Board of the City of Centerville; and

WHEREAS, a vacancy on said Board now exists and must be filled in order for said Board to function;

NOW, THEREFORE,

The Municipality of Centerville hereby ordains:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Centerville hereby appoints David S. Tooker to the Personnel Appeals Board of the term expiring December 31, 1973.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and shall become effective immediately upon its adoption. A public emergency affecting the public welfare is hereby declared to exist because of the fact that the City of Centerville is presently without full membership on the Personnel Appeals Board and the appointment of a member to fill that vacancy at the earliest possible date is essential in order that any cases filed may be expeditiously handled.
